Refraction Policy

The refraction exam is done by hand by the doctor to customize the glasses prescription for that single person. No two patients measure the same.

A refraction is a measurement of the lens power necessary to prescribe glasses or other corrective lenses. Most medical insurance plans, including Medicare, do not cover routine refractions or routine eye examinations (when no medical problem is known or suspected). Medicare allows that we charge separately for that portion of the examination, since it is not a covered service.

The cost for refraction is \$35.00; if you have a separate vision plan that covers routine or annual eye examinations and/or glasses, please let us know. Your vision plan may assist you with your eye care needs that are not covered by your medical plan.
